Remember, it is important to understand that chapters 7-11 are a response to questions that were asked by way of a letter. It would be helpful to see the questions, but The Lord has seen fit not to reveal them. This is another hard-to-understand portion of scripture.

Deuteronomy 24:5, 1 Corinthians 7:7

I. The distress of the day.

A. No command

Matthew 19:12 "For there are eunuchs who were born that way from their mother's womb; and there are eunuchs who were made eunuchs by men; and there are also eunuchs who made themselves eunuchs for the sake of the kingdom of heaven. He who is able to accept this, let him accept it."

B. Good advice

1. Take a look at the present

Distress: to compress or press tightly

2. Seriously consider your decisions

C. Your decision

2 Peter 1:3-4

II. The shortness of the day

Daniel 12:4 "But as for you, Daniel, conceal these words and seal up the book until the end of time; many will go back and forth, and **knowledge will increase.**"

Matthew 24:3-13

Matthew 24:42 "Therefore be on the alert, for you do not know which day your Lord is coming.

A. Marriage is short

1 Timothy 5:8 But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

B. Emotions are short

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 Rejoice always; 17 pray without ceasing; 18 in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

C. Possessions are short

Luke 12:15

D. Pleasures are short

2 Peter 3:10-11

III. The Change from the wedding day

A. The change of concern

Concern: to be anxious ahead of time

B. The change of interest

1 Peter 3:7

C. The change of distraction

Colossians 3:17

IV. The decision of the day

Numbers 30:3-5

A. The decision of concession

His vow was made for someone else. If he believes it is best for her to marry... then it is acceptable and not a sin.

B. The decision of commitment

The decision lies with the father.

C. The decision of what is best

This is a hard to apply passage, but the idea here is to do what is best in the situation.

V. The instruction for a future day

A. Bound will become unbound

Only in the Lord. 2 Corinthians 6:14

B. The recommendation to the unbound

A recommendation but not a command.
